#### **Silent Auction**

Having spent most of Friday setting up for the Silent Auction at St Mary Magdalen's I was not best pleased to wake up on the Saturday morning to find it had snowed overnight! However by lunchtime the white stuff had mostly melted away and the Auction proved to be a very worthwhile venture and raised just over £825 for St Michael's and St Mary Magdalen's. 119 of the 201 lots sold to 43 bidders. The highest bid was £50 for Lot 1110 a fold away car roof carrier which saw three bidders fighting to the last second. Thankyou everyone who supported this event - the donors, the bidders, the helpers, the bakers and of course the clearer uppers!
